KARATE CLASS RULES

Applicant attends the Karate class must comply all rules and regulations of the facility and classroom at all time, violation will result in termination of membership and ban from further attending karate class.

Rules for Karate class:

1. **No Discrimination**: we do not discriminate against anyone based on his or her race, religion, national origin, gender or sexual orientation.
2. **No fighting**: fighting is not allowed. Sparring under supervision of instructor only.
3. **Disrespecting others** is not allowed.
4. **Serious incidents**. Disruptive activities such as fighting, cursing, name calling, and loud argument, may result in termination of membership from Karate class. Serious incidents involving death or bodily injury, fighting, violence, facility damage, etc. must be reported to the Karate instructor immediately and the Karate instructor will report to Director of Operations or in writing within 24 hours of the incident.
5. **No alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons** are permitted on the premises or in the classroom.
6. **Use of karate or attacks outside of class other than for self-defense is not allowed and would result in not being able to attend the class.**
7. **Any injury or health problem must be reported immediately to the instructor.**
8. Students are expected to be ready to bow in at the start time. Students who are late must wait at the door until the instructor bows to them before entering the gym (late admittance is solely at the discretion of the instructor). Students are expected to finish the class and cannot leave early without instructor permission.

Policy Charges for Karate class:

1. **The fee for Karate class students is \$30 per month or \$75 for 3 months paid in advance, or an annual fee of \$250.00 prepaid. Applicant has 2 weeks to change his/her mind. Full refund will be reimbursed to you directly if you decided to withdraw from class for any reason within 2 weeks of class starting date.**
2. **Students must also join Shotokan Karate of America, which includes grading, SKA newsletters, and other benefits. The SKA national fee is \$50 for new members for the remainder of calendar year of 2007 (plus a \$75 new member renewal fee for the 2008 calendar year). The year 2007 SKA fee of \$50 is to be given to the instructor with the signed SKA membership form within first week of class. SKA membership must remain current to be admitted to the karate class. Other SKA members pay \$25/calendar year more than new members. SKA black belts pay a higher rate to SKA.**
3. **The hours of the class are Tuesday and Thursday from 7:30PM – 9:00PM** (excluding holidays, voting days, and emergencies).
4. The Director of Operations or Executive Director may waive all or part of the fee if it is in the best interests of UCSP to do so. UCSP fee is waived for SKA black belt instructors.
